Audition Process

Resumes and audio files/CD/DVD recordings must be received by August 1st, 2016. Once approved by the recruiter, applicants will receive an audition invitation letter. All invited candidates must be prepared to meet Air Force maximum allowable weight standards.

Please send a one page resume and preliminary recordings that meet the following requirements:

- Approximately 10-15 minutes in duration (live and/or studio recordings).
- Include as many of the following styles/groups as possible: pop, jazz, classical (concert band and/or orchestra), folk/country/bluegrass/celtic,.
